BAD BLOOD is brewing between those two exponents of chaste journalism, the N. E. Medical Monthly and the St. Louis Med. and Surg. Journal. The casus belli is to be found in the fact that "two stars keep not their motion in one sphere" and as each is an illustrious example of much that is pernicious in medical journalism a most venomous paper war is threatened. There is some hope that this enmity which menaces humanity with disaster may yet be appeased, for each of the doughty rivals finds time to abuse the PITTS-BURGH MEDICAL REVIEW, and on this common ground a reconciliation may be effected.
