

CHRISTIAN G. LEOPOLD, M.D.

Born in Meerane, Saxony, February 24, 1846. Honorary Fellow, 1891.

He pursued his medical studies at Leipzig, where he was a special student in obstetrics under Credé, and took his medical degree in that city in 1870.

Dr. Med., professor der genäcologie, Geheimer Medicinalrath. Director der Hoehn Frauenklinik und Hebammen-Lehranstalt; ord. Mitglied der Kön. landes Medicinal Collegiums in Dresden. He became a privat-docent at the Leipzig University in 1874, and instructor in the Midwives' Institute in 1881. In 1883 he was made an assistant professor and director of the maternity.

Member and honorary member of many learned societies.

Died in Dresden, 1912.
